Our Values cover all times of the school day and where young people are representing the Academy out of hours or off-site: Staff should ensure these values are embedded in routines within their classroom and for when young people are moving around the school.*

*It is everyone's responsibility to challenge young people where these values are not met, but equally to comment positively when they are.*

The updated behaviour policy has assisted staff to treat young people individually, taking their additional needs into account.
