Home teaching suspended until further notice

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are all already aware, schools across the country will be closed from Monday 23rd March until further notice.

Our home teaching team will still be at work and we will try to support all our young people by providing information updates and by setting and assessing work for those who will be able to work independently and/or with the help of other family members.

You will receive a phone call early next week from your allocated key worker who will be able to answer or follow-up on any general queries that you might have. In addition each teacher/support tutor will contact you next week at the time when they would normally be teaching your child.

We will be able to provide work via email or by post if internet access is not available. Teachers will discuss this with you when they phone.

Please also read the recent letters on our website (Parents Section) providing further information about the Covid-19 Pandemic and our Letter to Parents, 19 March 2020 from Tosin Gabriel, Vice-Principal.

Safeguarding (Safe and Well) checks will continue to be done on a weekly basis by telephone. Your key worker will discuss the arrangements for this with you when they call next week.
